- **1. Cover Page.** The Discovery Paper must include the following information to be considered for subsequent phases of assessment:
 - a. Name of Company
 - b. Company Address
 - c. Company POC
 - d. DUNS and Unique Entity ID (SAM.gov)
 - e. Company Size status (large/small)
 - f. OT eligibility assertion*

- 3. **Page Limitation.** Solution Briefs are limited to **TWO PAGES MAXIMUM** (not including the cover page).
